Conflict Minerals Statement

So called "Conflict Minerals" include tantalum, tin, tungsten and gold from the Democratic Republic of Congo and their neighbouring countries, the so called DRC region. Other regional areas in risk of conflict have lately been added (Latin America, Myanmar, Nigeria, etc.) and other raw materials like mica and cobalt.

According to the EU regulation 2017/821, importers to the European Union of tin, tantalum, tungsten, their ores, and gold are obliged to carry out a due diligence check of their supply chain. For processing companies like Phoenix Mecano AB, there is no direct obligations under EU regulation 2017/821.

Phoenix Mecano AB do not directly import conflict materials and nor do we have any information that products that we use contain minerals originating from conflict regions. Since we are at the end of the value chain we have very limited possibilities to trace the origin of the minerals included in our products all the way back to the original country. We however use primarily well know electronic component suppliers, aluminium extruders and steel producers known for their social responsibility in order to minimize the possibility of having Conflict Minerals in our products.
